2017 Annual Report

Meetings:

The Village of Vicksburg and their Wellhead protection team meet 4 times throughout the past years:

- December 1, 2016
- March 2, 2017
- June 1, 2017
- August 31, 2017

2017 Accomplishments:

- 1. The Village updated the contaminated source inventory list. Approximately 13 new sites since it was last updated in 2012.
- 2. Large Contaminated Source Maps were laminated and used for educational purposes
- 3. The Village routinely updated the Village's Website to include an environmental section containing articles and various links related to wellhead protection and storm water.
- 4. Village is promoted Rain Barrel Sale, "Connect the Drops" and Kanoe the Kazoo.
- 5. The Village continues implemented the environmental check-list with all new site plans.
- 6. The Sunset Homeowners were provided literature including: "Septic Tanks Why should I pump my tank", Can my water softener discharge to my onsite sewage treatment system?", and 4 page brochure, "Practical tips for home and yard".
- 7. The Village/VCS had a table at the 2017 Tailgate. Date was September 8th. Table was up from 3:45 to 6:15 (event ran from 4:00 to 6:15 pm). A public education survey was conducted (copy attached). 96 people completed the survey (50 more than last year). Approximately 20 pieces of literature were taken by residents and non-residents, along with 60 carabiners and 20 post-it-notes with "protect your water" and website information.
- 8. The Village applied for a 2018 WHPP grant.

2018 Goals:

- Purchase new products to promote wellhead awareness (re-usable shopping bags and can coolers)
- Purchase additional stock of carabiners with logos promoting wellhead protection
- Have a table with literature for public education at the 2018 VCS Community Tailgate.
- Publish two articles related to WHP/Stormwater topics (website and/or print version).
- Have quarterly wellhead meetings.
- Involve the Vicksburg Community Schools in continued educational efforts.
