2018 Annual Report

Meetings:

The Village of Vicksburg and their Wellhead protection team meet 4 times throughout the past years:

- August 30, 2018

2018 Accomplishments:

- 1. The Village routinely updated the Village's Website to include an environmental section containing articles and various links related to wellhead protection and storm water.
- 2. Village is promoted Rain Barrel Sale, "Connect the Drops", Master *Rain* Gardener Course and Kanoe the Kazoo.
- 3. The Village continues implemented the environmental check-list with all new site plans.
- 4. Mike Schwartz presented on March 9th on the Village of Vicksburg WHPP program to the Vicksburg Rotary Club.
- 5. Mike Schwartz and Ron Smith presented on wellhead protection program to the Sunset Lake Association meeting on June 13th.
- 6. The Sunset Homeowners were provided literature including: "Top 10 Ways to be a Good Septic Owner" and "Do Your Part, Be SepticSmart: The Do's and Don'ts of your Septic System".
- 7. The Village/VCS had a table at the 2018 Tailgate. Date was August 30. Table was up from 3:45 to 6:30 (event ran from 4:30 to 6:30 pm). A public education survey was conducted (copy attached). 70 people completed the survey. Approximately 20 pieces of literature were taken by residents and non-residents, along with 100 Bags, 30 carabiners and 50 can-cozies with "protect your water" and website information.
- 8. Vicksburg Community Schools published 2 article in the Red & White
- 9. The Village applied for a 2019 WHPP grant.
